Creation Museum & Ark Encounter

October 21-24, 2024 - 4 Days & 3 Nights

- Day 1 Leave Northside Baptist Church with a muffin and juice breakfast on the way to Kentucky. We will stop for lunch, <u>not included in the price</u>. We should arrive at the Hampton Inn, Florence KY around dinner time. There are three restaurants for dinner adjacent to our hotel: Cracker Barrel, Rafferty's, and Applebee's. Dinner is on your own.
- Day 2 We will spend the day at the Creation Museum. This state of the art museum allows you to venture through biblical history, stunning exhibits, botanical gardens, zoo, and more. We will have a lunch voucher to enjoy a meal on the premises of the Creation Museum. We will return to our hotel to rest and freshen up for our dinner cruise on the Ohio River on the BB Riverboat. We will cruise from 7-9 PM while enjoying delicious food and the beautiful scenery.
- Day 3 We will get an early start to travel to the Ark Encounter, where we will spend the day exploring the 510 foot-long, 51 feet high and 85 feet wide structure. Prepared to be blown away as you explore this enormous Ark loaded with displays and explanations which will answer the questions people want to know about this historic vessel. The Ark was built following the instructions in the Bible. It is amazing and will touch your heart. Don't forget to wear your walking shoes. We will enjoy lunch there using a meal voucher that is included in your tour. Our evening meal tonight will be at the Hofbrauhaus in Newport, KY where a special night of German food entertainment awaits.
- Day 4 Our final day will be spent traveling back home. We'll certainly enjoy the Fall foliage in KY, WV, and our native VA along the way. We will stop for lunch <u>on your own</u>, and enjoy a few snacks along the way as we talk about what a fun and inspiring trip we had.
